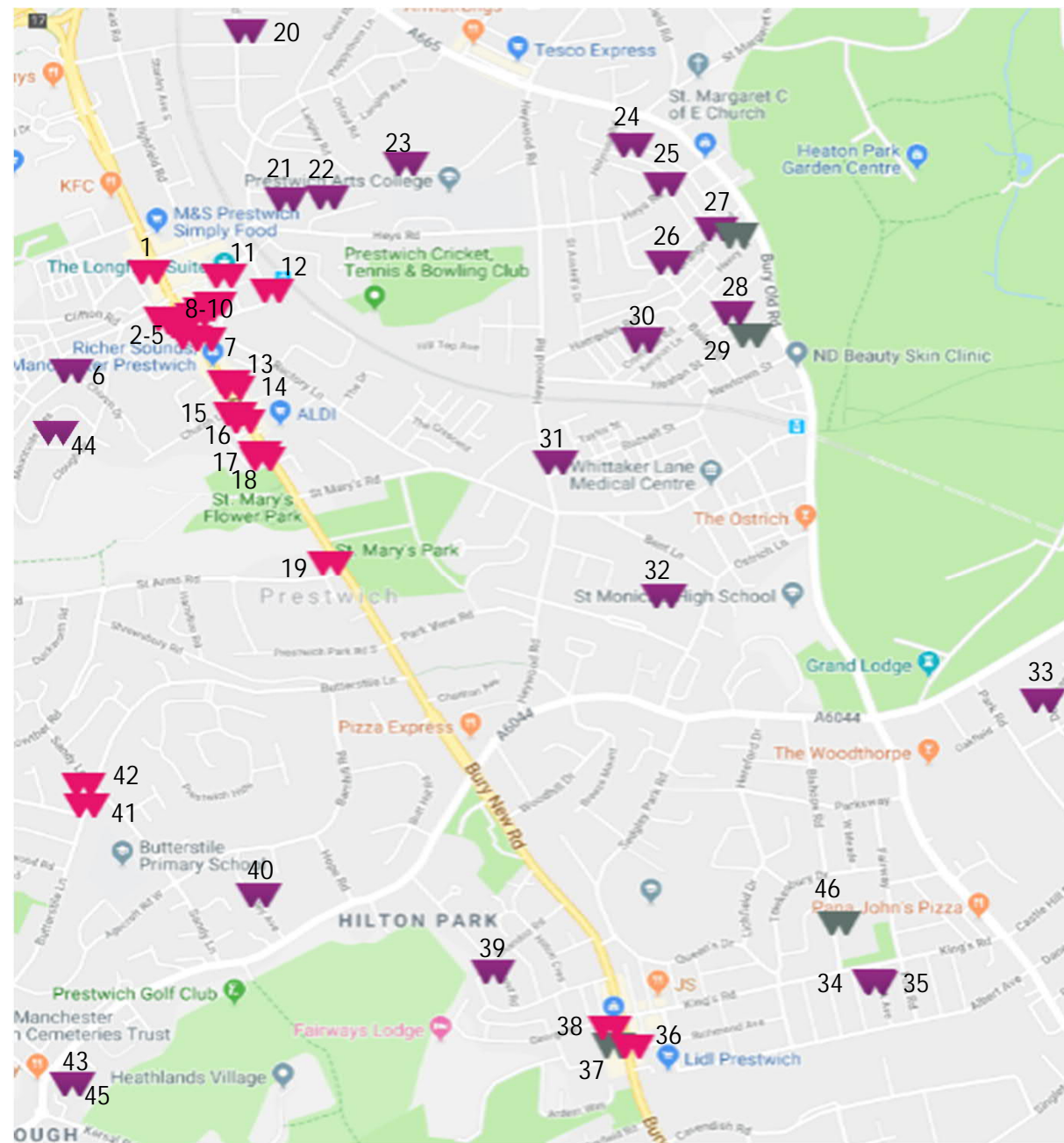

## PRESTWICH VILLAGE

1. Gallery 786, 499 Bury New Road, M25 1AD  
Local artist Ruth Goodman has painted a Life drawing of local Cllr Jane Black. Also exhibiting fine art watercolours by local artist Bronwen Bevin; 'Dog patiently waiting on a Wintry Kersal Moor' (This conservation area shares its border with Kersal in Salford and Sedgley Park in Prestwich) and 'The Delights of Christmas Day'.

Artwork can be viewed during opening hours throughout the art trail.

2. All the Shapes, 8 Warwick Street, M25 3HN  
All the Shapes are launching their latest exhibition: Craig Tattersall's 'Imaginary Bells & Landscapes' on 26<sup>th</sup> September. The art form is a series of curated photographs expanded from an old facsimile document of Alexander Bells and can be viewed inside the café bar during opening hours.

4. Basil & Lily, 449A Bury New Road, M25 1AF  
Prestwich based artist Janneke Calle has partnered with Basil & Lily to exhibit her locally inspired artwork. Janneke's art can be viewed inside the bar throughout the art trail, during business hours.

5. Pres, 441 Bury New Road, M25 1AF  
Pres is exhibiting the art of two local talents; Hannah Connor has created tiny resin frogs which have been inspired by the annual phenomenon of young frogs migrating across her Prestwich street and into Drinkwater Park.

Local photographer Madeleine Penfold is also exhibiting a collection of photographs of Gambia. Please check business hours.

6. Local Resident, 4 Arthur St, Prestwich, M25 3HE  
Locally inspired and created art that celebrates all things Prestwich!

44. Local Resident, 14 Mountside Crescent M25 3JF  
A 'Home is where the art is' themed garden... possibly a fairy garden! Take a look and see what artful delights you find!

7. Footprint Travel, 440 Bury New Road, M25 1AZ  
Footprint Travel Agents are displaying two pieces of art created by St Monica's High School Students. The pieces will be visible in the front door window throughout the art trail.

8. Village Greens, Longfield Centre, M25 1AY  
This year our favourite, local cooperative; Village Greens is exhibiting the art of two local artists; Jenny Unsworth celebrates the beauty in what some might consider 'past-it' flowers in her stunning artwork. Jenny's artwork can be viewed from the windows of Village Greens throughout the art trail. The second artist to exhibit, is the wonderful Myro Doodles who will be creating one of her famous window designs on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> September.

9. Claire's Cafe, Longfield Centre, M25 1AY  
Claire's Cafe have invited a local artist to create a piece of art inside the café – pop on in and take a peek during business hours.

10. You & Me Cafe, Longfield Centre, M25 1AY  
The 'Let's Paint Together' local community art group, which is lead by local artist Penny Hicks has created a wonderful 'Prestwich inspired' exhibition which can be viewed inside the café during opening times, throughout the art trail.

11. Prestwich Library, M25 1AY

This year our treasured Prestwich Library has a whole host of local community groups and students exhibiting their art for us all to enjoy.

Members of 'Prestwich Mum's' Group are exhibiting an array of wonderful art created by Prestwich based Mums, Dads and, of course, their little ones.

Reading Friends is a local community group that meet to make friends and companions with an aim of combatting loneliness. This year they have been supported by Penny Hicks to create mixed art forms especially for the 'Home is where the art is' art trail.

St Monica's High School have curated a selection of art from their many talented students. Along with their other pieces which are being exhibited as part of the art trail, it's a great opportunity to see the emerging Prestwich based artists of the future.

12. Creative Living Centre, M25 1BP  
We're delighted the Prestwich based mental health charity is taking part in the art trail once again for 2019.

Members of the centre have been busy creating art especially for the trail. Art will be displayed in the windows of the centre and also on pavement boards and main corridor when the centre is open. On Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> September the Sunshine Café will be open to members of the public between 17:30 – 20:30 for refreshments - a perfect opportunity to get a closer look at the art on display.

13. Time For Tea, 416 Bury New Road, M25 1BD  
Stuart Lomas Photography of wildlife and flowers and a film of Heaton Park will also be shown. Check opening hours.

14. Farah Naz, 408 Bury New Road, M25 1BD  
Farah Naz have partnered up with Spanish artist Mia Bonbon, who we're lucky to have visiting Prestwich during the festival.

Mia Bonbon's message speaks of powerful, beautiful, self-confident women, without complexes or ties. Her intention is to break those stereotypes that persecute women so much, generating messages like "Rubialize" or "we are all princesses" that have already created a revolution.

An explosion of colour, an ode to the aesthetics of Disney and a constant evocation of memories of the past, pop culture and the millennial generation. Mia Bonbon is a milestone to freedom of expression, creativity and the desire to grow up learning. After all, this is just the imaginary of a group of dreamers for the world."

15. 416 Grape to Grain, 1 Church Lane, M25 1AN  
Prestwich residents, Christina and Noel, have demonstrated their love for Prestwich through their new passion of photography, by creating postcards of some of the everyday locations of Prestwich. 'Postcards of Prestwich' was created during a stroll up Bury New Road.

16. Rose & Lee, 393 Bury New Road, M25 1AW  
The talented students of St Monica's have curated a selection of their favourite pieces from their art portfolios, some of which can be seen at other venues during the trail, including this fab home interiors shop,

during their open hours.

17. Jennie Platt Estates & Lettings, 371 Bury New Road, M25 1AW  
Exhibiting various art forms of local artists. Artwork available to buy so pop in, say hi to Jennie and the team and see what they have on display, during business hours.

18. Creative Calm Studio, 371 Bury New Road, M25 1AW  
Karen Walsh, Prestwich Resident, attends yoga teacher training at the wonderful Creative Calm Studio and is displaying some of her beautiful yoga themed pieces. Most of them can be seen from inside the studio during open hours, and one from the street, if you look up to the first floor window.

19. First Draught, 255 Bury New Road, M25 9PB  
Hazel, The Happy Chalk Board Designer and Illustrator will be drawing on the windows of first Draft, live from 11am on Sunday 22 September. The drawings depict the surroundings of Prestwich life with a few nods to the breweries that keep us coming back to First Draught for more!

20. 22 Nursery Road, M25 3DG  
Photographic prints and a large painting of Prestwich Clough are in store here!

21. 4 Newlands Drive, M25 3BU  
Back for the second year running, we get to see the Oil Canvas Display of this Prestwich resident

22. 32 Newlands Drive, M25 3BU

27. Bury Age UK, Sealand House, Vine Street M25 1NQ  
A range of art created by the local community group. During their weekly meet up's they've been busy getting creative.

28. 14 Bedford Street, M25 1HX1  
This resident has recently become really interested in Celtic knotwork and has illustrated an intricate Manchester Bee in a Celtic design.

Although Prestwich dates back to Anglo Saxon times, the Celtic tribe of the Brigantes controlled the area (along with a large part of Northern England) long before, so the resident wanted to represent some of that heritage in her stunning, Celtic knotwork design.

29. Heaton Park Methodist Church, (Heaton Street entrance), M25 1JA

As part of this interactive, community art installation, you're invited to see and get involved in art work that explores what it means to love our community. So why not pop along, join in and add your own 'heart for the community'.

You will have an opportunity to take a look around the Grade II Listed, Art Deco Building, learn about it's history. In addition to this you can pick up one of our art trail maps and speak to a Prestwich Art Festival volunteer.
